

Providing Feedback on Constructed Responses


1. To view constructed responses for students, you can select the feedback icon underneath the class name or you can choose the "Feedback" tab to the left.




2. Inside the feedback section of the platform, select the class name where the responses are located.




3. Next, select the assignment the constructed responses were assigned. If you don't remember the name of the assignment, go ahead and click "All."




4. In the example below, you can see I have eight assignments that need review. To review an assignment, click the red "REVIEW" button.




5. This is an example of a short constructed response. To review the prompt, click the "SHOW DESCRIPTION" arrow.




6. To the left is the learner's response, and on the right is the model response of what a score of 2 might entail.




7. Below the response, choose whether to accept the assignment for review or return it back to the student for revision.




8. After reading the student's response and comparing it to the model response, choose the score that best fits the student's performance level.




9. When you're finished, click the "SUBMIT & NEXT" button to go to the next response, or select "SAVE DRAFT & CLOSE" to return to the Feedback menu.




10. Grading the Extended Constructed Response is similar to the Short Constructed Response. You can view the prompt by clicking "SHOW DESCRIPTION" and you can view and accept the student's response for evaluation.




11. Click "View the Rubric" to access a 5-point rubric available to help educators determine a student's level of performance.




12. This rubric is designed to closely align with TEA's 5-point rubric.




13. Next, click the score that represents the student's performance.




14. When finished, click "Submit and Next" to review the next assignment or "Save Draft & Close" to exit and return to the "Feedback" menu.



15. To return to the dashboard, click the "Back to dashboard" banner in the upper left corner.
